**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 922 AND ORDINANCE
7-2022 OF THE CITY OF WINCHESTER, KENTUCKY CODE OF
ORDINANCES TO AMEND THE MEETING, QUORUM, AND ORGANIZATION
OF THE WINCHESTER LICENSING BOARD**

WHEREAS, The Winchester Board of Commissioners deems it in the public interest to set term limits for the Winchester Licensing Board; and

WHEREAS, The Winchester Licensing Board shall serve at the pleasure of the Winchester Board of Commissioners; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WINCHESTER, KENTUCKY THAT:

SECTION I. That the following language shall be changed for the Winchester Licensing Board.

ARTICLE III. –WINCHESTER LICENSING BOARD

Sec. 9-40. – Created; composition; terms and qualifications of members.

There is hereby created a Winchester Licensing Board, which shall consist of three (3) members, who shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Board of Commissioners, for terms of one year, and each of whom shall be a resident and qualified voter of the city, at least twenty-five (25) years of age and of good moral character and none of whom shall have any interest, direct or indirect, in any business located in Clark County, Kentucky, which would require a license approved by the Winchester Licensing Board if such business were located in the city. The members may serve for two (2) consecutive terms of one year each, after which they may be reappointed no earlier than twelve (12) months following the date of such member’s last service.

SECTION II. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION III. All portions of this Ordinance amending the Code designate words and figures, which are deleted by including such words and figures stricken with solid lines through the center. Words and figures added to the amendment are underlined. The codifier is instructed to omit the words and figures deleted and add the underlined text when codifying this Ordinance.
